The Bride or Groom must be a registered, contributing and active member of Mt. Carmel Parish for at least one year before requesting a marriage date.



Safeguard Our Children

All teachers, staff and volunteers in the Archdiocese must undergo fingerprinting and criminal background checks. Archdiocesan guidelines and abuse prevention training programs currently in use in the Archdiocese emphasize the importance of parents knowing who has access to their children at school and other church-sponsored activities.

Summertime is here, and parents should remain vigilant regarding who is granted access to their children. Make sure camp counselors have undergone criminal background checks. And, make sure you know the camp's "daily routine." In particular, make sure that no camp activity results in a child being left alone with one adult. All activities should be supervised by more than one adult, and the camp should be open to unannounced drop-in visits from parents.

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME ~ AUG. 3rd

The Responsorial Psalm Refrain of today's Mass summarizes the message of our Scripture Readings this Sunday: "The hand of the Lord feeds us; he answers all our needs". Matthew's Gospel (14:13ff) today tells us that Jesus in "his heart was moved with pity" when he saw the vast crowd. He cured the sick and multiplied the five loaves and fish to feed them in their hunger. Jesus fulfils the words of the prophet Isaiah (55:1-3) in the First Reading: "All you who are thirsty, come to the water...Come, without paying and without cost, drink wine and milk." All that is needed is that we listen and believe. We come to Jesus in the Holy Eucharist, our eternal banquet, to be refreshed in God's love, healing and mercy. Our deepest hungers and needs are placed before God who responds in love. In the Second Reading (Romans 8:35ff) St. Paul lists all that can harm our faith but God will stand with us so that nothing can "separate us from the love of God in Christ Jesus our Lord." In our needs, our trials and temptations, let us come to Jesus and his saving love so that we may have life now and forever!

- * Soon we will celebrate the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary into heaven Friday, August 15, a holy day of obligation. There will be a Vigil Mass on Thursday, August 14th at 5:30 PM. Masses on Friday, August 15th will be at 7:45 AM and 5:30 PM. Because school has not started yet, there will be no 9:00 AM School Mass on Friday, August 15th. More information will be found in next week's bulletin.
- * Work continues on some major renovation projects this summer.
- 1. The painting of the outside of the buildings of Our Lady of Mount Carmel School. Cost estimate: \$35,000 in labor, plus cost of materials.
- 2. Renovating the School Offices, administration and faculty area of the School. Cost estimate has risen close to \$30,000 because of the need to replace electrical wiring and other issues.
- 3. Repairing and renovating the Men's Rest Room in the Parish Hall because of a methane gas leak there. The door in the Women's Rest Room in the Parish Hall will also be replaced. This means that both Rest Rooms will be accessible to people in wheel chairs. Cost estimate: \$25,000.
- 4. Some heating and air conditioning repairs in the Rectory for the Pastor's Office and Fr. O' Sullivan's room. Cost: \$6,905.
- 5. Repairing and replacing the awnings at the Parish Hall and at the house and parking area of the home of the Pastor Emeritus. Cost: \$10,380.

We invite donations from generous parishioners and friends for any of these repairs/renovations. We are happy and grateful to report that three parish families have already responded to this invitation by donating \$12,711. Any gifts or donations would be helpful in meeting the many needs for maintaining and renovating our Church and School buildings.
