The First Sunday Of Lent

FEBRUARY 22, 2015

Your ways, O LORD, make known to me; teach me your paths.

— Psalm 25:4

FROM THE PASTORS DESK Fr. Steve

Lent begins, a time of renewal, of change, of growth, of new life in Christ, a new beginning. Noah and his family experience a new beginning after the Flood in today's First Reading (from Genesis 9:8ff) as God makes a covenant of peace and love with all living creatures, symbolized in the rainbow. In the Second Reading (from 1 Peter 3:18ff) St. Peter refers to Noah's ark and how we were saved in a similar way in the waters of Baptism. In Baptism the power of the death and resurrection of Iesus reaches us.

Lent calls us to rediscover these great realities of God's gift of life and love in Jesus Christ. As Jesus spent forty days in the desert, so for forty days we "repent" and turn back to God and his love and mercy in Jesus. We walk together towards Holy Week and the Baptism of new Christians and the renewal of our own Baptism at Easter. Prayer, fasting, almsgiving, daily Bible reading or Holy Mass. reaching out to others - these are some of the many ways we can come to new life in Jesus in these 40 days of Lent.

- This Sunday is Scout Sunday. Our Scouts will help in the celebration of Holy Eucharist at 10:00 AM and some Scouts will receive their Scout religious awards at this Mass.



Safeguard Our Children Child Abduction: Taking Action

A recent study of the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children® revealed that 83% of children who escaped their would-be abductors kicked, yelled, and pulled away to escape. Teach your child these and other abduction prevention skills, such as: Asking for permission before changing plans; asking for permission before approaching or getting into vehicles with anyone; recognizing the tricks would-be abductors use, such as offering rides or asking for help; telling a trusted adult whenever anything or anyone makes them uncomfortable.

When it comes to keeping your child safe, YOU are your child's best resource. The more you know about abduction prevention, the better protected your child will be. Use your knowledge to make conversations about personal safety a regular part of your family's routine.



TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Fasting may be a priority in your Lenten spring-cleaning regimen. Almost every religious tradition recognizes that fasting is a key to heightened spiritual awareness. You know this from your own experience. When you are engaged in a hobby, painting a room, keeping vigil near a delivery room, or standing watch at a sickbed, you may simply forget to eat. What you are doing so fills you that the intensity of the action is itself nourishing. In fasting from food, or drink, or habitual behaviors, you make room for what is truly important.

Even though Lenten Sundays stand apart from the Lenten fast, you will notice traces of fasting in our liturgy. We fast from singing the Gloria and Alleluia, we fast from flowers bedecking the altar, and there may be a noticeable drop in the number of infant baptisms as parents elect to wait until Easter. This hints that fasting is a prelude to feasting, and the vigor of our Easter alleluias is rich fare after a long silence. In the same way, even a small fast—no cream in the coffee, no pepper in the soup, no radio in the car—can not only point to deeper hungers, but help us rejoice more fully in the feast when we break our fast together.
