

How is it possible to be holy? Only through the grace and presence of God in our lives. In the Second Reading this Sunday St. Paul tells us that "you are the temple of God and the Spirit of God dwells in you...the temple of God, which you are, is holy." In today's Gospel Jesus continues the Sermon on the Mount and tells us how to live out our call to holiness: through love to others (offering no resistance to injury, turning the other cheek, loving one's enemies, praying for those who persecute you). At the Eucharist we come face to face with the all-holy God whose love, rain and sun shines on all, friends and enemies. At the Eucharist we are touched, redeemed, made holy by the presence of God.
