FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

We hear more parables of Jesus in today's Gospel (Matthew 13:24-43). Parables are short stories to teach us about God's way of seeing people and life. Today's parable are parables of growth, telling us that the Kingdom of God begins small and grows in amazing ways, just as a small mustard seed grows into the largest of plants. As part of God's Kingdom we are part of its becoming in the world, growing in goodness and love and peace and the life of God. We must also recognize that good and evil are mixed together in our personal life and in the life of the Church. God gives us many second chances. We must be patient with ourselves, gentle and merciful towards self and others, remembering that God "judges with clemency...with much lenience governs us...permits repentance for our sins" (as we hear in the First Reading today from Wisdom 12::13, 16-19). In the Second Reading (from Romans 8:26-27) St. Paul tells us that the "Spirit comes to the aid of our weakness, for we do not know how to pray as we ought". The Holy Spirit will help us to change and grow beyond our weaknesses through God's love and presence in our life.

• Each summer, a visiting missionary priest makes an appeal in our parish as part of the Missionary Cooperative Program of the Archdiocese. **Next Sunday**, Bishop Arulappan Amalraj, Bishop of the Diocese of Ootacamund, India, will speak and ask for our prayers and donations to help support the ministry of the Church in his diocese. Envelopes will be available in the pews for your donation to this worthy cause in the one collection at Offertory time next Sunday.

• We are blessed to have Father Liam O'Connell, S.J., with us to minister in the parish until his return to Ireland on July 28th. Father Liam is the cousin of Father Maurice O'Mahony, our Pastor Emeritus.

• Work has begun on some major renovation projects this summer:

1. The painting of the outside of the buildings of Our Lady of Mount Carmel School. Cost: \$35,500 in labor, plus cost of materials.

2. Renovating the School Offices, administration and faculty area of the School. Cost estimate: \$20,000

3. Repairing and renovating the Men's Rest Room in the Parish Hall because of a methane gas leak there. The door in the Women's Rest Room in the Parish Hall will also be replaced. This means that both Rest Rooms will be accessible to people in wheel chairs. Cost estimate: \$25,000.

4. Some heating and air conditioning repairs in the Rectory for the Pastor's Office and Fr. O'Sullivan's room. Cost: \$6,905

5. Repairing /replacing the awnings at the Parish Hall and at the house and parking area of the home of the Pastor Emeritus. Cost: \$10,380.

We invite donations from generous parishioners and friends for any of these repairs/renovations. Any gifts or donations would be helpful in meeting the many needs for maintaining and renovation our Church and School buildings.
