WHOLE COMMUNITY FAITH SHARING Week of June 1st — John17:1~11

Faith Reflection: In today's Gospel, we are privileged to listen to Jesus praying to his father. There is an intimacy and utmost care for his disciples but above all there is obedience to his father. He knows he must be glorified in accordance with his fathers will. Jesus anticipates His departure from "the world" realizing His followers cannot follow Him, He has concerns for their spiritual safety and is reluctant to leave them, yet He prays with an earnest love for His disciples and all who belong to God. Faith Response: Jesus prayed for His disciples that others might believe in Him through their words. How am I spreading my belief in Jesus through my words and actions?

Faith Question: I will look for opportunities to be one with God this week.

Safeguard Our Children By Teaching "Total Body Safety" We Further Efforts To Stop Child Sexual Abuse

When teaching parents, stress, that their child's entire body is private and to be watchful of adults who might be "grooming" a child by constantly tickling, kissing, or hugging them. A child will often tell a parent he or she does not want to hug or kiss someone. Teach parents to listen to their children and respect their wishes! Stress to teens the importance of "total body safety" in their relationships with others. Tell them, "Just because a person is a close friend or even a girlfriend or boyfriend, that does not give them a right to touch you in a way that makes you feel uncomfortable." By teaching "total body safety" to adults, children, and young people, we are furthering our efforts to stop child sexual abuse and to make the world a safer place for all of God's children.

THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Ascension of the Lord. In the First Reading (from the Acts of the Apostles 1:1ff) we hear that Jesus "was lifted up and a cloud took him from their sight." This is a way of saying that Jesus was ending his frequent appearances to the First Christians after Easter and was entering into the timeless, glorious presence of God. The Second Reading from Ephesians 1:17ff speaks of his glory and exaltation with God "at his right hand in the heavens, far above every principality, authority, power and dominion..." In these human words Paul is telling us of the cosmic dimensions of Christ's victory over sin, death, Satan, all forces of evil everywhere. Christ's glory and light fill all of us and our whole universe.

At the time of the Ascension (in the First Reading today) Jesus says: "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you and you will be my witnesses..." Between Ascension and Pentecost (next Sunday) the First Christians gathered in prayer with Mary, the Mother of Jesus, in Jerusalem waiting for the coming of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. May we also pray this week: "Come, Holy Spirit, Come! Fill our hearts with the fire of your love! Bring us to life anew as Christians so we can be witnesses to Jesus in our world!"

• At the 10:00 AM Mass this Sunday we will have special celebrations with the adults who have walked with us in the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults) on Tuesday evenings since last September. Four adults baptized in other Christian Churches will make their Profession of Faith and be received into the Catholic Church; one Catholic adult will then join them in receiving the Holy Spirit in the Sacrament of Confirmation and celebrating their First Holy Communion. Eight other adults in this class received the Holy Spirit in Confirmation through the ministry of Bishop Curry on May 18. Please pray for all the adults as we celebrate God's love for them in these Sacramental celebrations in our Church. Our parish is blessed in their presence with us.
