

FEAST OF SAINTS PETER AND PAUL, APOSTLES

Today we celebrate the Feast of Saints Peter and Paul, Apostles. The Eucharistic Preface for today's Mass summarizes the meaning of today's celebration: "Lord, holy Father, almighty and eternal God... by your providence the blessed Apostles Peter and Paul bring us joy: Peter, foremost in confessing the faith, Paul, its outstanding preacher..." In today's Gospel (Matthew 16:13ff), we hear Peter's great confession of faith in Jesus: "You are the Christ, the Son of the living God." We also hear the Lord's commissioning of Peter to be the "Rock" on which the Church is built. We look to Peter the Apostle and his successor today (Pope Francis) as the Center of unity and faith in the Church. We also look to Paul the Apostle who spent his life preaching the Good News of Jesus as Savior of all. Peter and Paul had to grow and mature in faith through many trials and difficulties and ultimately die as martyrs for Christ. We too are called to grow daily in our faith and in our relationship with the Lord and in unity of faith in his Church. In life and death may we also walk with Christ and bring Christ to others.

- * We celebrate the great blessing of freedom in our land as we celebrate Independence Day, July 4th, on Friday. We invite you to come and celebrate our nation's independence at Holy Eucharist at 7:45 AM. A Happy Fourth of July to all!
- * We welcome to our parish this week-end Father Liam O'Connell, S.J., the cousin of Father Maurice O'Mahony, our Pastor Emeritus. Father Liam has come to serve at Mount Carmel each summer for the last sixteen years. He will be with us until July 28th.
- * As Father Liam arrives, Father Steve, our Pastor, leaves on his annual vacation. He will return to Our Lady of Mount Carmel on July 28th.
- * Work begins soon on some major renovation projects this summer:
- 1. Painting the outside of the buildings of Our Lady of Mount Carmel ~ Cost: \$35,500 in labor, plus cost of materials.
- 2. Renovating the School Offices, administration and faculty area of the School Cost estimate: \$20,000
- 3. Repairing and renovating the rest rooms in the Parish Hall so they are accessible to people in wheel chairs: estimates still being prepared
- 4. Some heating and air conditioning repairs in the Rectory: Cost: \$6,905
- 5. Repairing/replacing the awnings at the Parish Hall and at the house and parking area of the home of the Pastor Emeritus: \$10,380
