



### FR. STEVE

On this First Sunday of Lent we begin 40 days with Jesus in the desert, struggling with great questions of temptation, sin, death and life. The story of Adam and Eve in the First Reading is the story of each person. The Fall of our First Parents happens in our lives today also. Yet we are free to choose goodness, virtue and life in Christ following his example in the Gospel. St. Paul tells us that although in Adam all died, "how much more did the grace of God and the gracious gift of the one man, Jesus Christ, overflow for the many" so that in Christ we all come to life. Now is the time to turn to Jesus each day in Lent as the whole Church goes through a communal conversion to God and reconciliation with God and with each other.
