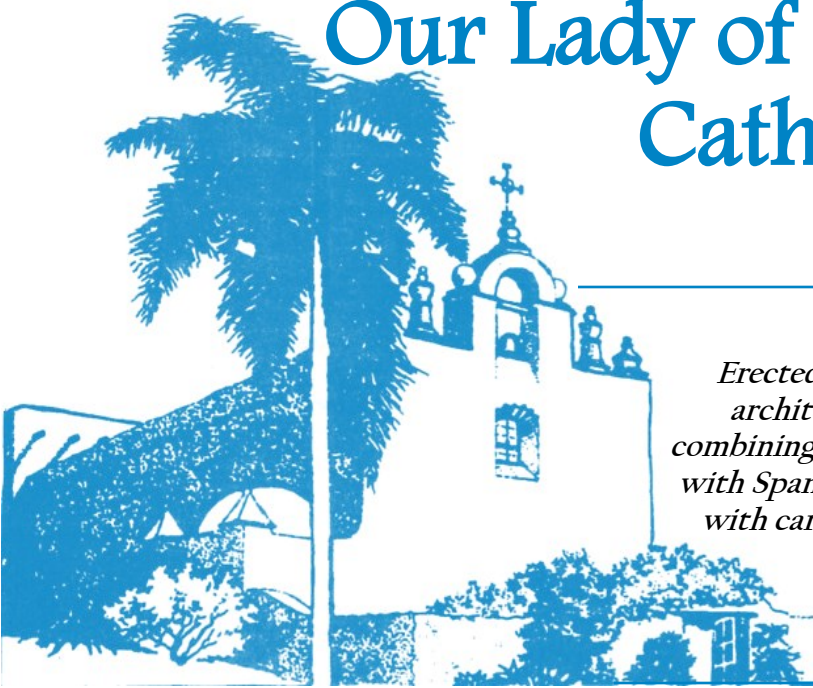


Our Lady of Mount Carmel Catholic Church

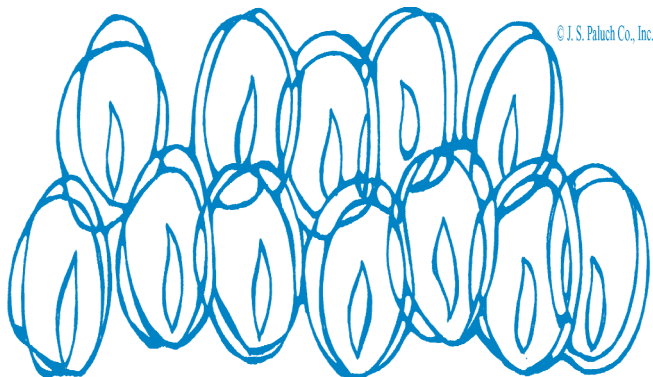

Our Easter joy reaches its fullness on this Pentecost Sunday as we celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles and First Christians gathered in prayer with Mary the Mother of Jesus in Jerusalem. Great changes take place in their lives as the Holy Spirit comes upon them. Filled with the Holy Spirit they go out into the streets of Jerusalem and to the ends of the earth proclaiming Jesus as Savior of all.

Today the Holy Spirit comes upon as we pray in the beautiful Sequence Prayer after the Second Reading: "Come, Holy Spirit come...Shed a ray of light divine! You, of comforters the best; You, the soul's most welcome guest...O most blessed Light divine, shine within these hearts of yours, and our inmost being filli..Heal our wounds, our strength renew...wash the stains of guilt away; guide the steps that go astray...On the faithful, who adore and confess you, evermore in your sev'nfold gift descend; give them virtue's sure reward; give them your salvation, Lord; give them joys that never end..."

On Monday we return to Ordinary Time in the Church year - the thirty four weeks of the Church year that are not part of the Advent-Christmas or Lent-Easter seasons. All time is sacred to God and every Sunday is of great importance as the day of the Lord's resurrection and the day of the completion of creation. Let every Sunday be a day of worship together at Eucharist and a day of play and rest in God's love - a true sabbath!

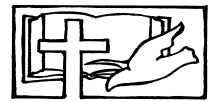

Week of May 24th - John 20:19-23

Faith Reflection: Jesus promised to send a paraclete (advocate, helper) to his disciples to be with them always. This is Pentecost Sunday, the fulfillment of the promise to send the Holy Spirit to kindle the fire of our faith. When the resurrected Jesus first appears to the fearful apostles in the upper room his first words are "Peace be with you". He repeats this phrase before he shares the power of the Holy Spirit with them.

Faith Question: When Jesus says, "Peace be with you," what do I think he has in mind?

Faith Response: This week I will be aware of the power of the Spirit, giving me the right words, giving me insight into dilemmas, or in other ways.

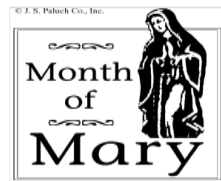

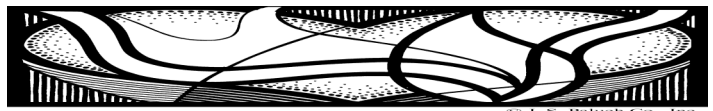


May — Month Of Mary

RECITATION OF THE ROSARY



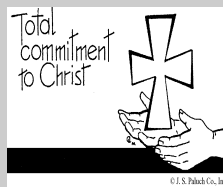
The Rosary is recited everyday after the 7:45 am Mass.
